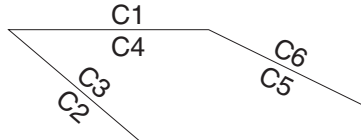
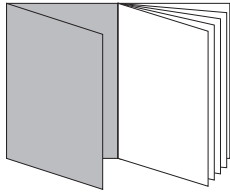
PUBLICATION STEPS AS FROM DECEMBER 2017

### Formats



#### 1. Gatefold on the second cover

##### Bleed (to be added to the dimensions given below)

5 mm on the top and bottom

10 mm at the back (C5 and C6)

C1 = 222 mm

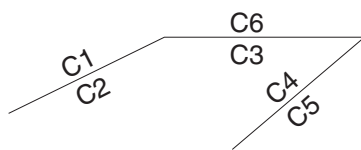
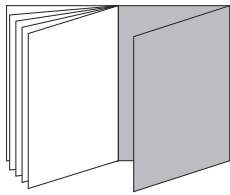
C2 = 217 mm

C4 = 222 mm

C5 = 225 mm

C6 = 225 mm



#### 2. Gatefold on the third cover

##### Bleed (to be added to the dimensions given below)

5 mm on the top and bottom

10 mm at the front (C1 and C2)

C1 = 225 mm

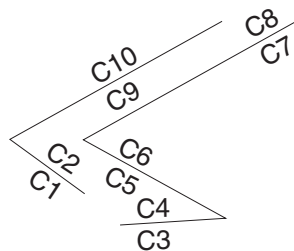
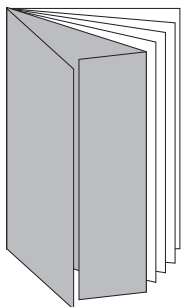
C2 = 225 mm

C3 = 222 mm

C4 = 217 mm

C5 = 217 mm

C6 = 222 mm



#### 3. French door

##### Bleed (to be added to the dimensions given below)

5 mm on the top and bottom

10 mm at the back (C7, C8, C9 and C10)

C1 = 108 mm

C2 = 108 mm

C3 = 118 mm

C4 = 118 mm

C5 = 220 mm

C6 = 220 mm

C7 = 225 mm

C8 = 225 mm

C9 = 225 mm

C10 = 225 mm

*C4 should be attached to C5 by two glue points (one glue point on top and one at the bottom).*

#### Paper (maximum weight per m<sup>2</sup>)

Gatefold on the second cover = 90 g/m<sup>2</sup>

Gatefold on the third cover = 115 g/m<sup>2</sup>

French door = 115 g/m<sup>2</sup>

- Remarks:
- All gatefolds supplied, have to be of the same format and weight per m<sup>2</sup>.
  - The grain direction of the paper has to be parallel to the back to avoid the fold from tearing.
  - If the print run exceeds 50,000 copies, please provide a 2% waste. If the print run is equal to or less than 50,000 copies, please provide a waste of 1,500 copies.
  - Perforations in the back may cause the fold to tear!

#### Packaging and delivery

**BLANKS:** 6 weeks before publication, 200 blanks accompanied by a note of dispatch have to be sent to Roularta Media Group, Linda Taillaert, Meiboomlaan 33, 8800 Roeselare.

**PACKAGING:** The inserts have to be supplied folded, stacked in packets that are not crossed if possible. See page Stacking instructions and pallet specifications.

**DELIVERY:** 4 weeks before publication at Roularta Media Group, Linda Taillaert, Meiboomlaan 33, 8800 Roeselare.

**Every supply of material should be accompanied by a note of dispatch containing at least the following information: the client's name, the advertiser's name, date and title of all editions using the material, the subject and a reference to the corresponding order number.**
