<p>** When delivering 3<sup>rd</sup> party code, it is important to take into account the following guidelines:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Attention please: in order to guarantee the visibility of your advertisement, it is of the utmost importance that your 3rd party material is hosted on a HTTPS site. If a  precedes the URL, the site is not secure. If a  precedes the URL, the site is secure.</li> <li>in case a z-index is sent, it can have a maximum value of 9000. (the z-index determines the position of the HTML elements in the various layers of the web page. An element with a higher z-index will be put on top of an element with a lower z-index).</li> </ol> <p>All interruptive rich media advertising executions (Overlayer, expandable, ...) should feature a close button in the top right hand corner. The close button should appear on every frame of the execution. The close button should appear in the top right next to the content or the actual visible ad content (cfr. when there is a transparent background). The close button should be clearly visible at all times with special consideration taken about the background colours of the web page the creative is running on. If you link those external libraries (jquery etc.), the request should be done through HTTPS (SSL).</li> <li>The number of files is limited to 15, to avoid slow charging.</li> </ul>
